



3rd Annual Australian Geothermal Energy Conference and Trade Show

Announcement

The official geothermal conference

This is the official conference of the Australian geothermal industry, and the only one supported by the Australian Geothermal Energy Association (AGEA), the Australian Geothermal Energy Group (AGEG) and Australian geothermal energy companies.

Registration will be less than \$1,000 for the three day event and will include a geothermal trade show, unique to this event. This conference builds on last year's highly successful meeting, which attracted over 400 attendees.

The Australian Geothermal Energy Conference will feature keynote addresses from international and domestic leaders in the geothermal exploration and development sector, plus speakers from government, academia and research institutes. We will cover issues of science, technology, policy and finance.

Conference structure and themes

Pre-conference workshops will be held on Tuesday 16 November.

Day one, Wednesday 17 November, investors and financiers will provide an update of latest developments nationally and internationally and there will be presentations from leading Australian geothermal energy companies.

Days two and three, 18 and 19 November, are more technical and policy in nature and will provide concurrent sessions covering geothermal energy exploration, evaluation and development covering:

- **Exploration**
- **Underground Science & Technology**
- **Power conversion technologies**
- **Legislation, policy and infrastructure**
- **Finance panel (raising capital in difficult times)**
- **Direct Use**

This conference will uniquely bring together representatives of Australia's entire multidisciplinary geothermal community plus the finance, government and research sectors in one place for three days. In addition, international keynote speakers have been invited to provide a snapshot of key global projects and trends. Please join us.

Trade show

A comprehensive industry trade show will be held in conjunction with the conference for the full three days, utilising the fantastic facilities at the Adelaide Convention Centre and providing delegates with hands-on learning and networking.

Registration costs

The cost of attendance for the three days will be less than \$1,000 and will include conference resources, meals and admission to the trade show.
